Forecast/Conditions: Expect good trail conditions with fresh grooming over some drifted and wind-blown snow. There is a 40 percent chance on snow during the day Friday. Friday night low around -12F. Expect race time temperature around zero F with mostly cloudy skies.

Glidewax: Apply Performance Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush. Apply High Performance Blue Hot Wax, sprinkle on X-Cold Powder, iron in together, scrape and brush. Due to the recent wind-blown snow and likely fresh snow on Friday, we are not recommending the High Performance Liquid Paraffin as the final layer.

Gripwax: Roughen base with 150 grit sandpaper, iron in Nordic Base Wax Green, cork smooth, let cool. Then apply several layers of Nordic GripWax Blue, corking between layers. Finish with 1 or 2 layers of Nordic GripWax X-Cold, corking between layers. Those often needing extra kick should skip the X-Cold and finish with the Blue.

Structure: A fine structure covered by one pass with the Blue Structurite tool after scraping and brushing HP Hot Wax will best suit these conditions.

All Race Wax Tips recommend ONLY fluorine-free products. Older HP or P Toko waxes (Liquid or Hot Wax) contain fluorine. New labels look very similar but all say PFC Free.
