

# WAX RECOMMENDATION



## Tour of Anchorage 25K

APU to Kincaid Park, Anchorage, AK

Sunday, March 6

10 A.M. Skate, 10:30 A.M. Classic

Skate/Classic technique races

Wave starts, Point to point

Forecast/Conditions: Overnight low 24 with an 80 percent chance of light snow. Snow temperature at start approaching 30, 30 percent chance of light snow. Snow temperature at finish approaching 32. Cloud cover, older machine groomed wet snow with new mixed in. Snow isn't clean, but also isn't super dirty.

Glidewax: Apply High Performance Red Hot Wax, scrape and brush. Spray on HP LP Yellow, let stand overnight, then polish with the Polishing Brush Liquid Paraffin. If you do not have LP spray, apply BP Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush, then apply HP Yellow Hot Wax, scrape and brush.

Gripwax: Roughen kick zone with 150 grit sandpaper, iron in Nordic Base Wax Green, cork smooth, let cool. Then apply 4 alternating layers of Nordic GripWax Yellow and Red, corking between layers. Final layer should be Red. If using skin skis, treat skins with Eco Skin Proof. For best performance, apply Eco Skin Proof the day before the event.

Structure: A wet/universal structure covered by one pass with the Yellow Structurite tool after scraping and brushing HP Hot Wax or before spraying HP LP will best suit these conditions.

All Race Wax Tips recommend ONLY fluorine-free products. Older HP or P Toko waxes (Liquid or Hot Wax) contain fluorine. New labels look very similar but all say PFC Free.
