

# WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO<sup>®</sup>**

## **Ski Rodeo**

Liberty Bell High School, Winthrop, WA

Saturday, December 31

10 A.M. 15K first wave start. Lollipop at 1:15 P.M.

15K, 10K, 3K, 1K, Freestyle technique

Mass start by wave (see website for details)

3 laps of partly separate courses per distance

**Forecast/Conditions:** Overnight low of 19 rising to 30 by race completion. Temperature at 10 A.M. near 24, mostly cloudy skies. Continued warm and moist snowfall during the past week should yield partially transformed, clean and semisoft conditions that should break down a bit by the third lap.

**Glidewax:** Apply High Performance Red Hot Wax, scrape and brush. Spray on High Performance Yellow Liquid Paraffin, let stand overnight, then polish with the Polishing Brush Liquid Paraffin. If you do not have LP spray, apply BP Red Hot Wax, scrape and brush, then apply HP Yellow Hot Wax, scrape and brush.

**Gripwax:** N/A. Those choosing to classic should iron in Base Wax Green to a sanded kick zone, let cool and then apply 3-4 layers of GripWax Red (or Yellow for late races), corking between layers.

**Structure:** A fine structure covered by one pass with the Red Structurite tool after scraping and brushing the final Hot Wax or before spraying HP LP will best suit these conditions.
