

WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO[®]**

White Pine Nordic Trails, Pinedale, WY

Saturday, January 28

Forecast/Conditions: Heavy snow forecasted through Saturday. Friday night low of 18 degrees and 16 start temperature. A 70 percent chance of 2-4" snow on Saturday with gusts up to 20 mph. PistenBully will plow as much snow as possible off the course Friday evening and possibly early Saturday morning. Expect a tilled mix of transformed and new snow on a soft track.

Glidewax: Apply Base Performance Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush. Then apply High Performance Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush.

Gripwax: Roughen base with 150 grit sandpaper, iron in Nordic Base Wax Green, cork smooth, let cool. Then apply 2-3 light layers of Nordic GripWax Blue, corking between layers. If additional kick is needed, substitute the second layer with GripWax Red and cover with Blue.

Structure: A fine structure covered by one pass with the Blue Structurite tool after scraping and brushing the final Hot Wax will best suit these conditions. Be sure to follow with the Nylon Polishing Brush after structuring.

If you do not have High Performance wax, substitute Performance or Base Performance wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue), as the temperature ranges are the same. All Race Wax Tips recommend ONLY fluorine-free products. Older HP or P Toko waxes (Liquid or Hot Wax) contain fluorine. New labels look very similar but all say PFC Free.
