Forecast/Conditions: Overnight low of 9F with snow temperature at start around 15. Old transformed and somewhat dirty snowpack. A 50 percent chance of light snowfall during race but we have not seen any 50 percent chance snowfall forecast materialize in quite some time.

Glidewax: Apply High Performance Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush. Spray on High Performance Blue Liquid Paraffin, let stand overnight, then polish with the Polishing Brush Liquid Paraffin. If you do not have LP spray, apply BP Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush, then apply HP Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush.

Gripwax: N/A

Structure: A fine structure or making one with one pass with the Blue Structurite tool after scraping and brushing the final Hot Wax or before spraying HP LP will best suit these conditions.

All Race Wax Tips recommend ONLY fluorine-free products. Older HP or P Toko waxes (Liquid or Hot Wax) contain fluorine. New labels look very similar but all say PFC Free.
