

# WAX RECOMMENDATION



## Concord Area Learn-to-Ski Clinic

**Forecast/Conditions:** Overnight low 2F, temperature warming up to 38F throughout the day with cloudy skies. Snow will be firm and frozen in the morning, softening up in afternoon.

**Glidewax:** Apply High Performance Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush. If doing Morning Clinic, stick with HP Blue Hot Wax. If attending Afternoon Clinic, apply HP Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush, then apply HP Liquid Paraffin Red, let sit overnight, then brush with the Polishing Brush Liquid Paraffin. If you do not have LP spray, apply BP Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush, then apply HP Red Hot Wax, scrape and brush.

**Gripwax:** Roughen base with 150 grit sandpaper, iron in Nordic Base Wax Green, cork smooth, let cool. Then apply 2-3 layers of Nordic GripWax Blue, corking between layers. For Afternoon Clinic apply 1-2 more layers of GripWax Red, corking between layers.

**Structure:** A fine structure covered by one pass with the Blue Structurite tool after scraping and brushing the final Hot Wax or before spraying HP LP will best suit these conditions. If snow warms up a lot in the afternoon, a universal structure covered by one pass with the Red Structurite tool will be best.

All Race Wax Tips recommend ONLY fluorine-free products. Older HP or P Toko waxes (Liquid or Hot Wax) contain fluorine. New labels look very similar but all say PFC Free.
