Forecast/Conditions: Wintery mix Thursday with 1 inch of accumulation. New snow, sleet, rain mix will be tilled in with new snow. Low of 23 overnight, Saturday morning temperature at race time in the mid-20s, high in the low 30's. A 90 percent chance of snow during the day.

Glidewax: Base Performance level waxes only for the BKL Festival. Apply Base Performance Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush. Then apply Base Performance Red Hot Wax, scrape and brush.

Gripwax: N/A

Structure: A universal structure covered by one pass with the Red Structurite tool after scraping and brushing the final Hot Wax will best suit these conditions.

All Race Wax Tips recommend ONLY fluorine-free products. Older HP or P Toko waxes (Liquid or Hot Wax) contain fluorine. New labels look very similar but all say PFC Free.
