

WAX RECOMMENDATION TOKO®

Twilight Classic

Bogus Basin, Boise, ID

Tuesday, January 30

5:30 P.M.

10K/5K/3K/1K, Classic

Mass start, 2 loops

Forecast/Conditions: Monday night low of 26 degrees, Tuesday sunny with a high of 47 and race start in the low 40s. Track will be groomed at 3 P.M. with double classic tracks. Expect a glazed track. This is a hilly course!

Glidewax: Apply HP Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush, spray on HP Liquid Paraffin Yellow, let stand at least 2 hours, then polish with the Polishing Brush Liquid Paraffin. If you do not have LP spray, apply BP Red Hot Wax, scrape and brush, then apply HP Yellow Hot Wax, scrape and brush.

Gripwax: Roughen base with 150 grit sandpaper, apply Nordic Base Klister Green, heat, smooth and let cool. Apply Nordic Klister Red, heat, smooth and let cool. Add an additional short layer of Klister Red underfoot if additional kick is needed. If using skin skis, treat skins with Eco Skin Proof. For best performance, apply Eco Skin Proof the day before the event.

Structure: A universal structure covered by one pass with the Yellow Structurite tool after scraping and brushing the final Hot Wax or before spraying HP LP will best suit these conditions.

If you do not have High Performance wax, substitute Performance or Base Performance wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue), as the temperature ranges are the same. All Race Wax Tips recommend ONLY fluorine-free products. Older HP or P Toko waxes (Liquid or Hot Wax) contain fluorine. New labels look very similar but all say PFC Free.
