Lap-based format racing against the clock

Forecast/Conditions: Saturday rain and snow showers between noon and 3 P.M. and then snow showers after 9 P.M. Cloudy with a low around 27. Sunday chance of snow, cloudy, with a high near 34. Due to snow temperature, glazing is likely.

Glidewax: Apply HP Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush, spray on HP Liquid Paraffin Red and Yellow, let stand overnight, then polish with the Polishing Brush Liquid Paraffin. If you do not have LP, apply BP Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush, then apply HP Red Hot Wax/HP Yellow Hot Wax, scrape and brush.

Gripwax: N/A

Structure: A universal structure covered by one pass with the Red Structurite tool after scraping and brushing the final Hot Wax or before spraying HP LP will best suit these conditions.
