Forecast/Conditions: There will be heavy wet snow falling on top of an amazing manmade snow base Thursday night into Friday. Temperature will drop into the single digits F Saturday night. Expect a firm deck and tracks of well mixed fresh and manmade snow with race time temperature between 15-20. The deck and tracks will break down with the multi-lap format.

<u>Glidewax:</u> Apply HP Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush, spray on HP Liquid Paraffin Blue, let stand overnight, then polish with the Polishing Brush Liquid Paraffin. If you do not have LP, apply BP Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush, then apply HP Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush.

Gripwax: N/A

<u>Structure:</u> A fine structure covered by one pass with the Blue Structurite tool after scraping and brushing the final Hot Wax will best suit these conditions.
