WAX RECOMMENDATION



OOSIK CLASSIC RACE AND TOUR

Mile 11 Gravel Pit, Talkeetna, AK - Saturday, March 8 Noon, 50k, Classic Wave start, 1 or 2 laps <u>https://www.denalinordicskiclub.org/oosik-ski-race/</u>

Forecast/Conditions: Overnight low 19, snow temperature at start close to 30, approaching 32 later in the race. Dusting of new snow over transformed corn snow, partly sunny. Course will be mostly flat and fast. No tracks set on lakes. Some grass mixed on the uphill sections due to low snow year.

<u>Glidewax:</u> Apply BP Red Hot Wax, scrape and brush, then apply HP Yellow Hot Wax, scrape and brush. Sprinkle on <u>Jet Powder</u> Yellow, make two passes with iron at 18oc, let cool, scrape and brush. Polish with a merino wool roller. Then spray on <u>Jet Liquid</u> Yellow, let the ski dry flat for at least 20 minutes. No need to brush or polish Jet Liquid before skiing. If you do not have Jet Liquid Yellow, spray on HP Liquid Paraffin Yellow let stand at least 2 hours, then polish with the Polishing Brush Liquid Paraffin.

Gripwax: Roughen base with 150 grit sandpaper, iron in Nordic Base Klister Green, cork smooth, let cool. Then apply Nordic Klister Red, smooth, let cool. Alternatively, apply Nordic Spray Klister Base Green and thumb it to smooth it out. Then apply a thin layer of Nordic Klister Red, smoothing it out with a thumb or spatula.

Structure: A Wet structure covered by one pass with the Yellow Structurite tool after scraping and brushing the final Hot Wax or Jet Powder but before applying Jet Liquid or HP LP will best suit these conditions.

Race Service: Toko will be providing gripwax service on ALL TYPES of skis at the event as a fundraiser for the Talkeetna Junior Nordic Program. See the crew at the Yellow Toko Tent.
