

WAX RECOMMENDATION



MBSEF POLE PEDAL PADDLE

Mt. Bachelor Nordic Center, Bend, OR - Saturday, May 17

Nordic ski starts from about 9:20 A.M. to 11 A.M., 6k, Freestyle

Staggered wave starts, one loop

Forecast/Conditions: Friday night low around 34, partly cloudy. Race time temperature between 35 and 39. Overcast, light winds and an 80 percent chance of light snow during the event. Expect little to no accumulation. After the first few waves, the snow should soften quickly. Soft flex skis are recommended.

Glidewax: Apply BP Red Hot Wax, scrape and brush, then apply HP Red Hot Wax, scrape and brush well. Then spray on Jet Liquid Yellow, let the ski dry flat for at least 20 minutes. No need to brush or polish Jet Liquid before skiing. If you do not have Jet Liquid, finish with HP Red Hot Wax.

Gripwax: N/A

Structure: A universal structure covered by one pass with the Yellow Structurite tool after scraping and brushing the final Hot Wax and before applying Jet Liquid will best suit these conditions.
