SPAM CUP MASS START FREESTYLE SKI RACE

Rendezvous Ski Trails, West Yellowstone, MT – Sunday, Feb 15

11:30 A.M., 10k, Freestyle

Mass start, multiple laps

Forecast/Conditions: Overnight low 19, temperature at start 34, partly sunny skies with a high of 39, high humidity and new dry snow.

Glidewax: Apply HP Red Hot Wax, scrape and brush, lightly rub on Jet Bloc red, polish with the Rotary Brush Merino Wool, repeat the Jet Bloc Red and rub/polish for a second coat. Then quickly (1 to 2 seconds) spray [Jet Liquid](#) Red tail to tip, spread and polish using a handheld Thermo Cork, and go ski.

Gripwax: N/A

Structure: A universal structure covered by one pass with the Blue Structurite tool after scraping and brushing the final Hot Wax or polishing the Jet Bloc but before applying Jet Liquid will best suit these conditions.
