11 A.M., 1.2k, Freestyle

Sprint, Qualifier and Heats

Forecast/Conditions: Overnight low of 30 rising to 37 at the start of the qualifier. Expect the snow to have high moisture content and be a mix of new and manmade snow. Expect the snow to glaze, especially for later heats.

Glidewax: This event has a wax protocol that allows only ironed in paraffin wax. Apply HP Blue Hot Wax/HP Yellow Hot Wax mixed 1:1, scrape and brush. Polish with a merino wool roller to finish.

Gripwax: N/A

Structure: A universal structure covered by one pass with the Yellow Structurite tool, applied with a lot of force, after scraping and brushing the final Hot Wax will best suit these conditions.
