

WAX RECOMMENDATION



YELLOWSTONE RENDEZVOUS RACE

Rendezvous Trails, West Yellowstone, MT -- Saturday, March 7

8:45 A.M. 25k Classic, 9 A.M. 50k/25k Skate, 9:20 A.M. 10k/5k/2k

Wave starts, 25k lap

Forecast/Conditions: Overnight low 12, temperature at start 20, warming to 30 by 11 A.M. under partly cloudy skies. One inch of new snow fell Wednesday night and 1-3 inches of snow forecasted Thursday, one half inch on Friday. Track will be firm with a mix of transformed and new snow. Snow will be glazing in the classic track and in the skate track as the temperature warms.

Glidewax: Apply HP Blue Hot Wax/HP Red Hot Wax mixed 1:1, scrape and brush, sprinkle on [Jet Powder](#) Blue, make two passes with iron at 180c, let cool, scrape and brush using the copper brush and polish with a merino wool roller. Then quickly (2-3 seconds) spray [Jet Liquid](#) Blue tail to tip, spread and polish using a handheld Thermo Cork, and go ski. For 50k skiers who will be finishing after noon, use HP Red Hot Wax, Jet Powder Red and Jet Liquid Red.

Gripwax: Roughen base with 150 grit sandpaper, iron in Nordic Base Wax Green, cork smooth, let cool. Then apply 2-3 layers of Nordic GripWax Red, corking between layers. Finish with one layer of GripWax Blue and gently cork smooth.

Structure: A universal structure covered by one pass with the Blue Structurite tool after scraping and brushing the final Hot Wax or polishing the Jet Powder but before applying Jet Liquid will best suit these conditions.
